Secretary Vilsack,

As leading organizations and companies in the U.S. hemp industry, we proudly endorse and strongly support the grant proposal by Tennessee State University alongside the University of Tennessee, the Tennessee Department of Agriculture and the Hemp Alliance of Tennessee to the United States Department of Agriculture's Partnerships for Climate-Smart Commodities program. This project would reinforce two critical missions of our industry: agricultural sustainability and the pursuit of racial justice.

Funding for this project will create an opportunity for the implementation of climate-smart production practices, create methods for measuring, monitoring, and verifying the carbon capture and greenhouse gas benefits, and develop markets for hemp as a climate-smart commodity by enhancing availability and access to industrial hemp through a sustainable supply chain, from planting to production.
