MISSION STATEMENT

EQUITABLE INDUSTRY

We will foster equitable participation and ownership in the hemp industry by encouraging fair and inclusive business and hiring practices among our members, helping to reduce the barriers to hemp-related banking and merchant services, and serving as a resource for mentoring, employment, contracting and investment opportunities for minority-owned enterprises.

CONSCIOUS COMMUNITIES

We will foster conscious communities by supporting the development of a hemp industry that promotes environmental security, assists disadvantaged communities, and encourages responsible corporate citizenship.

RESTORATIVE JUSTICE

We will foster restorative justice by urging reforms that provide industry opportunities to non-violent felons, and by advocating for measures that redress past official discrimination against minority farmers and address hemp's tragic legacy in profiting on slave labor.

EQUITABLE ACCESS

We will foster equitable access for consumers by helping ensure the sale of trustworthy and transparently-labeled hemp and CBD products, to protect against the proliferation of unsafe products and predatory schemes which disproportionately impact minority communities.
