A DECADE IN THE MAKING

January 2012 - Jonathan Miller publishes article in the Huffington Post, arguing for cannabis legalization; Kentucky Agriculture Commissioner James Comer reads it and enlists Miller's help in efforts to legalize hemp in Kentucky.

July 2012 - Miller and four farmers and activists join, ultimately forming the Kentucky Hemp Industry Council (KHIC), aimed at introducing and passing hemp legalization.

April 2013 - SB 50 signed into Kentucky law, legalizing hemp in the Bluegrass State.

September 2013 – Comer and KHIC representatives meet with Sen. Mitch McConnell (R-KY), plotting path toward federal hemp legalization.

2014

February 2014 - Under McConnell's leadership and that of Rep. Jared Polis (D-CO), 2014 Farm Bill passes with provision to allow states to launch hemp pilot programs. August 2014 - Comer, assisted by the KHIC, wins a federal court battle with the DEA, allowing hemp seeds to be imported and pilot programs to commence.

2015 2016 2015-2016 - KHIC leads lobbying efforts on Capitol Hill to ensure federal spending bills include riders to prohibit DEA from interfering with state pilot programs.

February 2017 – With dozens of members from across the country, and the fight for federal legalization paramount, KHIC is rebranded as the U.S. Hemp Roundtable (USHR).

August 2017 — Understanding the need to develop high standards and best practices for the industry, USHR works with industry leaders to develop a guidance plan for an independent, self-regulated organization (SRO).

2018 May 2018 - USHR seeds funding for the establishment of the U.S. Hemp Authority (USHA), an independent SRO to administer the guidance plan for industry standards. **December 2018 –** After years of lobbying by the USHR, and the leadership of McConnell, 2018 Farm Bill is signed into law with provisions to permanently legalize hemp and hemp products like CBD.

> **December 2018 –** Food and Drug Administration (FDA) announces its opinion that CBD ingestible sales are illegal, but will work toward a regulatory pathway for their sales.

March 2019 - Working with Reps. Ed Perlmutter (D-OR) and Andy Barr (R-KY), USHR helps secure an amendment to the SAFE Banking Act providing a safe harbor for hemp farmers and CBD businesses.

May 2019 - General Counsel, Jonathan Miller, testifies at the FDA's first public hearing on hemp-derived CBD. August 2019 - Collected data for the development of a federal multi-peril crop insurance program for hemp, providing affordable options to U.S farmers.

October 2019 - USHR Board meets with the USDA to discuss the Interim Final Rule for the U.S. Domestic Hemp Program; USDA adopts most of USHR's proposed recommendations.

2020

July 2020 – Launched its Minority Empowerment Committee (MEC) and adopted an ambitious equity and inclusion framework, designed by the prestigious Annie E. Casey Foundation.

September 2020 - Worked closely with Reps. Kurt Schrader (D-OR) and Morgan Griffith (R-VA) on the introduction of the first House bill to establish a legal and regulatory pathway for the sale of hemp-derived extract products, such as CBD, as dietary supplements. September 2020 - Led lobbying efforts to ensure hemp farmers were eligible for the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP).

October 2020 - New York released hemp regulations reflecting USHR feedback to remove age restrictions on ingestible hemp products and cosmetics.

March 2021 - Worked closely with the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services to develop a regulatory pathway for CBD in food and beverages for the state. May 2021 - Supported the introduction by Sen. Ron Wyden (D-OR) of the first Senate bill which would establish a legal and regulatory pathway for the sale of hempderived extract products, such as CBD, as dietary supplements or food and beverage additives. October 2021 - California passed AB 45 after a three-year effort led by the USHR and local hemp groups to end the state's prohibition on retail sales of CBD products.

February 2022 - Rep. Chellie Pingree (D-ME) introduced The Hemp Advancement Act of 2022 with strong support and collaboration from USHR.

April 2022 - Hosted a D.C. Fly-In for Board Members to meet with 14 members of Congress and staff. July 2022 - Vice President and CEO of Kentucky-based Ecofibre, Eric Wang, testified at the first House Agriculture Committee hearing on hemp and CBD. September 2022 - Hosted a D.C. Fly-In for Members to meet with Congressional leaders and staff, culminating in a private dinner with Sen. McConnell and former Transportation Secretary Elaine Chao.
